Welcome to the Callingwood-Lymburn Community Playschool (CLCP). We are a non-profit parent co-operative program offered by the Callingwood-Lymburn Community League. We are located within Lymburn Elementary School at 18710 72nd Avenue, are licensed by the Province of Alberta, and as part of the community league are incorporated under the Societies Act of Alberta. Our school has adopted the Learn Thru Play philosophy, believing that helping children to use their imagination fosters



wonderful daily opportunities for learning. The purpose of the playschool is to provide enriching pre-school experiences for children from the ages of 3 to 5 years old.

We are accepting registration for our 3 year old T-Th classes & 4 year old M-W-F classes. Classes can fill up fast and names are then collected on a waitlist.

DID YOU KNOW? Children who are turning 3 on or before December 31 can participate in our 3 year old program! The child must be potty trained. Children who turn 3 after the first day of classes must attend with their parent/guardian until the child turns 3 years of age. Such attendance can only occur if the child's third birthday is on or before December 31. If the child's birthday is after December 31, the child's spot can be guaranteed only if the parents pay the registration fee and tuition fees for the duration of time between the start of school in September and the child's birthday.

A complete registration must include ALL necessary forms of payment attached to the registration form. Only complete registrations will secure your child's spot on the class list.
